Well over 200 years old, Maitreya House is a charming stone cottage situated in four acres of fields, with stunning views overlooking rolling hills and farmland. The house has been lovingly restored over the last nine years to create a meditation centre and haven for Dharma teaching and personal retreats. Many visiting Lamas from all over the world are invited to teach here, and it is closely linked with The Orchard, a Healing Shiatsu and Meditation Centre just across the road.

The property, which can accommodate up to ten people plus camping, consists of the house itself with three bedrooms (two double), bathroom, large kitchen, eating room, and beautiful living/teaching room with panoramic views across undulating hills. There are chalets in the grounds, with a utility block housing showers, toilets, and washing facilities. The roads surrounding the property are country lanes that offer many places of stillness and beauty to walk along, plus access to routes across the fields.

Founded as a charity by the late Venerable Namgyal Rinpoche in December 1982, the Crystal Group oversees the running of Maitreya House, and takes care of its upkeep and maintenance, which is in need of regular ongoing funds.

To safeguard the upkeep of Maitreya House there is need for a guaranteed regular income. For this purpose we have created a ***Guardianship Scheme*** inviting people to become a Guardian of Maitreya House. As a Guardian one commits oneself to a monthly standing order towards the maintenance of this beautiful venue and the flow of the Dharma.

The Crystal Group survives financially through funds generated from retreats and other donations. We have on-going expenses in restoring and maintaining Maitreya House, and are actively seeking ways to raise funds to meet these commitments, and to maintain our activities as a key centre for the study of Buddha Dharma. The Guardianship scheme assists us in this.

Founded as a charity by the late Venerable Namgyal Rinpoche in December 1982, the Crystal Group oversees the running of the center and takes care

of its maintenance, which is ongoing. They have found some innovative ways of raising funds to maintain the center, which offers so much to so many.

One of these is a guardianship scheme whereby members offer to become a guardian of Maitreya House. They would commit to a monthly standing order – amount of their choosing – which in turn contributes to the maintenance of the center and continues to feed the flow of Dharma.
